The campaign highlights house rehabilitation efforts in communities across the nation

Rebuilding Together (RT), the nation's largest volunteer-based provider of home-repair services, is marking the rehabilitation of RT's 100,000th house. The Rebuilding Together – St. Louis event is part of a celebration launched by Rebuilding Together National and its affiliates across the United States; the goal of the celebration is to focus attention on the work done by more than 3 million volunteers and the delivery of more than \$1 billion in home rehabilitation services since RT's inception 18 years ago.
