Rebuilding Together-St. Louis awarded \$68,000 in Missouri Tax Credits

Qualified donors can utilize tax credits through the Missouri Neighborhood Assistance Program

WEBSTER GROVES, Mo. – Rebuilding Together-St. Louis has received an allocation of \$68,105 in tax credits for 2008-2009 from the State of Missouri Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP). Qualified donors have used 20% of the credits thus far.

By making a donation to Rebuilding Together-St. Louis of \$500 or more, qualified donors will be able to utilize NAP Tax Credits - allowing one to get half of their contribution back as a tax credit on their Missouri taxes next spring. Those utilizing NAP tax credits will not only get a credit on their taxes next April; the donor will also provide funding for low-income homeowners to receive free home repairs through Rebuilding Together-St. Louis. A donor's gift will be worth more than twice as much as the actual donation.

Rebuilding Together-St. Louis uses the donations from the NAP tax credit program to support programming that allows low-income homeowners to remain safe and comfortable in their homes. Through the generosity of donors and the NAP tax credit program, Rebuilding Together-St. Louis can maximize its fundraising efforts in the community.
