Camp Hope is located in St. Bernard Parish in the town of St. Bernard, LA. It is a 30 minute drive to downtown New Orleans.

Capacity

The entire facility can accommodate 800 individuals but Rebuilding Together NOLA holds 100 beds /month for the National Work Weeks. **Rooms** are divided by gender, dormitory style, and each has 12-15 bunks (to sleep 24 - 30, though sometimes less). You must bring your own bedding; sheets, pillows, blankets, and/or sleeping bag. Each room is air-conditioned and the building has centralized air. Electrical outlets are limited.

Shower and Bathroom

Showers are private stalls located on the second floor. There are 13 showers for men and 13 showers for women. Restrooms are located on both the first and second floors. There are 16 for each sex.

Kitchen/Dining Facilities

Meals are provided daily by an AmeriCorps*NCCC team. Vegetarian options are available at every meal. During the breakfast hours they provide sandwiches, fruit, and water for volunteers to pack for lunch. All food is prepared in a clean, large kitchen. The dining hall is able to hold 800 people.

Computers

The facility has a public computer with Internet access. Wireless Internet is available on the first floor only.



Lounge

There are rooms where volunteers watch TV and/or read books. This is a meeting room/game room. There is also a separate conference room that is for large group meetings.

Laundry Facility

Available on site and cost \$1 for each washer and dryer. Laundry soap and fabric softener are available to purchase.

Safety

The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen belongings. Please limit your valuables. Please bring a small padlock if you wish to use our lockers.

Curfew

Monday - Thursday - MIDNIGHT; Friday - Sunday- 2AM.

Quiet time

10PM - 6AM; during this time, all voices must be kept to a whisper; phone calls must be taken outside and any radio/televisions must be turned off.
